生產者責任計劃應涵蓋所有飲品包裝類型

- 咁坊聯同免「廢」暢飲要求生產者責任計劃應涵蓋所有飲品包裝類型
- 香港有足夠能力處理於本地收集到的紙包飲品盒、膠樽和玻璃樽
- 本地首間紙包飲品盒回收場咁坊已經收集及處理超過一千六百萬個紙包飲品盒

香港，2021年3月24日 - 2019年，有多達27,374公噸的紙包飲品盒被棄於堆填區內，較前年升了12%。政府在公眾諮詢中提出生產者責任制只涵蓋塑膠飲料容器，這亦指會有35%的飲品包裝(參考附件1)不被列入立法監管內。

咁坊聯同免「廢」暢飲要求政府於將來的生產者責任計劃內，涵蓋所有飲品包裝類型，以避免無意地提供誘因轉用較難循環再造的包裝。

資訊機密處理有限公司執行董事(咁坊營運者)葉文琪指出：「即使在疫情的挑戰下，咁坊自2019年11月開幕以來，經已從香港市面上收集超過一千六百萬個用後的紙包飲品盒」

葉續指：「位於元朗工業村的打漿設施有能力每日處理高達20公噸的紙包飲品。我們將紙纖維從紙包飲品盒(由塑膠、鋁箔和紙板製成)抽出，並送到外地製成日常用品，如紙皮箱、紙袋、文具、貓砂3D、打印耗材。」

免「廢」暢飲(由不同界別持份者所組成的聯盟)主席司馬文說：「我們支持生產者責任制的公眾諮詢，這將會是一個推動香港循環經濟的良好機會。」

司馬文補充：「政府諮詢文件中遺漏了膠樽以外的包裝，生產者責任制將提供誘因予消費者和他們的代理人交回飲完的飲品包裝作回收。香港屬於一個開放型自由經濟體，進口飲品佔本地4成市場。進口商和消費者較容易去選擇相對較複雜去回收的包裝：如袋裝容器或紙包飲品。香港有能力於本地回收紙包飲品，將來的生產者責任制立法應涵蓋所有飲品包裝類型」

咁坊、免「廢」暢飲成員、政府和不同社區組織一直攜手合作建設一個本地紙包飲品盒的循環經濟。全港各區都設有紙包飲品盒回收箱，地點如學校、超市、便利店、區議員辦事處、屋苑、商場和由政府營運的回收環保站、回收便利點。

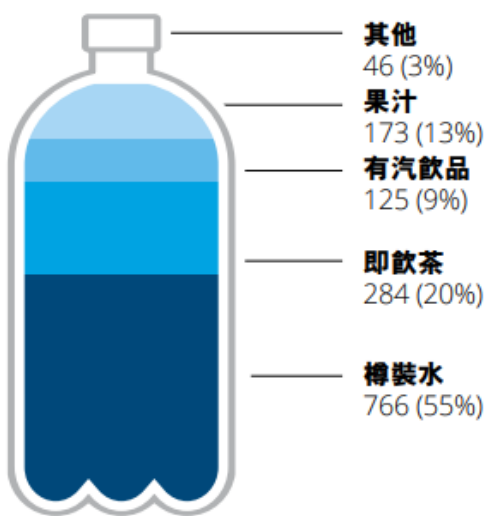

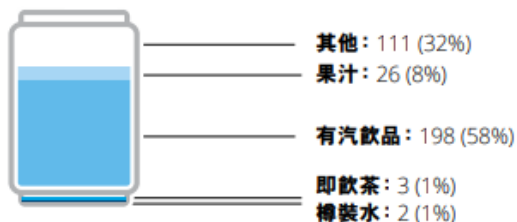

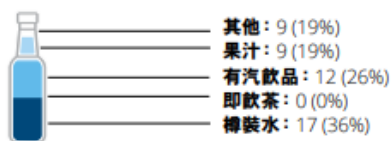

All Beverage Container Types Should Be Included in the Producer Responsibility Scheme

- Mil Mill and *Drink Without Waste* call for “all-in”, comprehensive scheme
- Hong Kong is capable to process liquid cartons, plastic bottles, and glass bottles locally
- Hong Kong’s very own Mil Mill has collected and processed over 16 million liquid cartons

Hong Kong, 24 March 2021 – In 2019, over 27,374 tonnes of liquid cartons were disposed at the landfills, a 12% increase from the year before. In the [PRS public consultation](#), the Government proposed to only cover plastic beverage containers. A combination of 35% of the beverage packaging (See Annex 1) will be missed out in the legislation.

Mil Mill and *Drink Without Waste* call for the Government to include liquid cartons in the future producer responsibility scheme (PPRS), to avoid unintentionally provide incentives to shift to less recyclable packaging.

“Despite the challenges under the pandemic, Mil Mill has processed over 16 million liquid cartons from the Hong Kong market since opening in November 2019”, said Harold Yip, Executive Director of SSID (operator of Mil Mill) and a participant of *Drink Without Waste*.

“In Yuen Long Industrial Estate, the pulp processing facility has the capacity to process up to 20 tonnes of liquid cartons a day. We separate the paper fibre from the multi-layer packaging (polymer, aluminium, and cardboard), the material will then be exported to produce everyday items, such as cardboard boxes, paper shopping bags, stationaries, cat litter, and 3D print filament.”

“We welcome the public consultation. It is a great opportunity to create a circular economy for beverage packaging in Hong Kong. It will provide incentives to consumers and their agents to return used beverage packaging for recycling”, said Paul Zimmerman, Chairman of the cross sector coalition *Drink Without Waste*.

“One of the major missing pieces in the consultation document is other beverage container types. Hong Kong is an open and free economy. Beverage importers make up 40% of the local market. Importers and the consumers can easily shift to other – less recyclable – packaging such as pouches or liquid cartons. Hong Kong has the ability to process liquid carton locally. Therefore, we urge the Government to include all beverage packaging in the future legislation of the producer responsibility scheme,” explained Mr Zimmerman.

Mil Mill and other participants of *Drink Without Waste*, the Government and Hong Kong community have been working closely together to build a local closed loop economy for liquid cartons. There is a wide network of collection points across the territory, including schools, supermarkets, convenience stores, district councillor offices, housing estates, shopping malls, and Government-operated Community Recycling Stations and Stores.

Drink Without Waste is an initiative of the Single-Use Beverage Packaging Working Group, an alliance with participants across the beverage value chain, resources management and NGOs. Since December 2017, the Working Group, has developed strategies and actions to reduce waste from the consumption of beverages. Its participants are building recycling plants, enhancing the recyclability of packaging, and have rolled out different schemes to collect beverage packaging including plastic bottles and liquid cartons in Hong Kong. 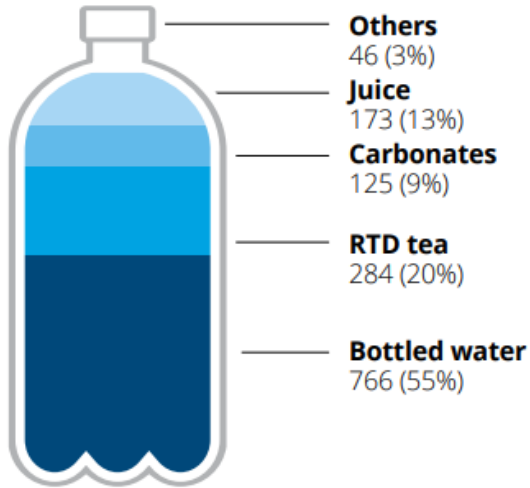

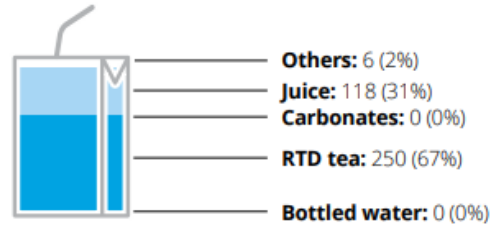

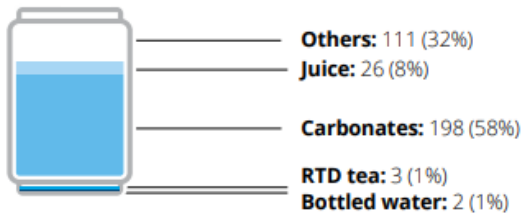
PET bottles

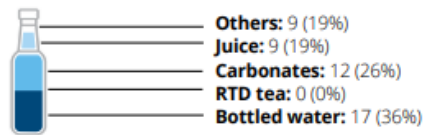
Liquid cartons
